We add 'est' to make the superlative form. clean → cleaner / cleanest; cold → colder / coldest; small → smaller / smallest; young → younger / youngest; tall → taller / tallest; There are some spelling changes. Superlative and Comparative Adjectives The irregular forms in comparative adjectives are the same for superlative adjectives. So the superlative form of far is (the) furthest, bad becomes the worst and good is the best. Comparatives and Superlatives Practice Comparative or superlative. We add -est to one-syllable adjectives to

make the superlative form . eg cold " colder " coldest. If a one or two-syllable adjective ends in -y, we change the y to an i before adding -est. eg sunny "sunnier "sunniest.
